### About the Society

The Ross Ferry Marine Park is located on the scenic Bras d'Or Lake in Cape Breton, Nova Scotia. The Park is on the site of the ferry which operated for many years between Ross Ferry and Big Harbour, across the Great Bras d'Or Channel. Today, we have a vibrant community park which includes picnic areas, walking trails, wharf facilities, a boat launch, and a children's playground, all in an idyllic shore setting of the Bras d'Or.

### Job Duties

The Park Attendant is the face of the Ross Ferry Marine Park and the primary duties are to keep the park clean and tidy, and to assist visitors.

#### General Park Maintenance:

- Cut grass and whipper snip edges
- Wipe down picnic tables and benches
- Check boat ramp and clear any debris
- Empty garbage and recycling receptacles
- Ensure grounds are clear of garbage and debris
- Assist with putting out and taking down signage
- Help stock, clean and maintain park building/kitchen

**Privy Maintenance:** at the beginning and end of each shift, the privy needs to be cleaned for our visitors. This includes sweeping of floors, cleaning of toilet, stocking toilet paper, paper towel and hand sanitizer.

**Walking Trail Maintenance:** walk the trail to ensure there is no garbage. Ensure all walking paths are clear of branches, slicks, stones etc. Check tables and benches to ensure they are safe to use. Report any maintenance issues to the supervisor.

**Misc Duties:** On Sundays, assist with BBQ, Fries & Pop sales. Receive payment from boaters using boat-slip and record boat-slip traffic in & out. Greet visitors and help answer general questions.
