This includes sweeping of floors, cleaning of toilet, stocking toilet paper, paper towel and hand sanitizer. Walking Trail Maintenance: walk the trail to ensure there is no garbage. Ensure all walking paths are clear of branches, slicks, stones etc. Check tables and benches to ensure they are safe to use. Report any maintenance issues to the supervisor. Misc Duties: On Sundays, assist with BBQ, Fries & Pop sales. Receive payment from boaters using boat-slip and record boat-slip traffic in & out. Great visitors and help answer general questions.
